

## MANABI - ECUADOR

Tour Activity Level:  Easy  Moderate  Demanding

### Tour Description

#### MACHALILLA NATIONAL PARK

- Los Frailes Beach is a crescent shaped beach with cliffs on both sides providing good shelter from the wind. The water is crystal clear and very warm. On calm days the waves are very small, otherwise it has small to medium sized waves which are fun for jumping and boogie boarding for teens and adults. The waves are strongest at the center of the crescent, making it suitable for all ages and swimming abilities. Also you will walk for a short path through a Palo Santo forest to get a viewpoint, from where you can see beatiful beaches and then you can enjoy this beautiful beach resting in it's white sands.
- Agua Blanca is a commune in Machalilla Parish, Manabí Province. It is east of the city of Puerto López. The community has a small church and a museum in the center of the village. The church is fantastically painted in bright colours. The area itself is in Machalilla National Park and it requires a small entry fee for tourists. The park is home to a sulphur lake which smells strongly of rotten eggs. The water and the underlying mud are extremely good for the skin because of the sulphur in deposits. Around the lake one frequently sees humming birds feeding at the flowers overhanging the water.
